### **PROJECT TITLE**

Rural Youth: Let's Awake the Opportunities

#### **GENERAL INFO AND MAIN AIM**

This project is supported by Regional Youth Cooperation Office – RYCO within its first Open Call for Project Proposals.

Main aim of the project is to contribute to empowerment of rural youth in communities of societies; Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Macedonia, Montenegro, Kosovo\* and Serbia.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- -To develop the competencies of the participants in areas of entrepreneurship, social entrepreneurship and project management.
- To encourage the participants to become active in their communities by addressing community challenges.
- To increase capacities of partner organizations to realize quality activities addressing the needs and interest of rural youth.

The international activities will take place in Durres, Albania and Struga, Macedonia.

### **PROJECT ACTIVITIES**

In the framework of the project will be addressed the needs and challenges through two types of activities:

**two international training courses** with the aim to build the knowledge of rural youth and their competencies that they can apply in their future life.

And **series of local activities** that would provide the participants an opportunity to materialize their ideas into concrete actions and to experience the process of making change.

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### **TARGET GROUP**

- Young people, from rural areas
- Age **18-30** years old
- Very good command in English Language
- Previous experiences in the field of project management, entrepreneurship and social entrepreneurship is NOT required. However we inform you that the trainings are open for active young people/ youth leaders in their communities who do not need to have necessary experience with the topics but be ready to actively share new competences in their organizations/communities.
- Strong motivation to apply new learned knowledge in practices and be involved in the local activities

It is important to **maintain gender balance in the activities** for this reason a preselection of the participants will be made from YSC Albania, afterwards the partner organizations will conduct the final selection phase.

### NOTE

The same participants have to attend in both training courses

### **METHODOLOGY**

Trainings will be based on non-formal methodology. During the trainings the participants will take part in interactive lectures, presentations, problem solving challenges. They will work individually (individual assignments), in mixintercultural teams. Participants will take part in debates, discussions, reflection and evaluation activities (reflection groups, 'face to face' feedback). Study visit element will be used to provide the participants an opportunity to learn from local practices and gain better understanding of the challenges that youngsters, youth organizations, social entrepreneurships are facing. Methods implemented during the project will be used to support active participation of the participants and creating open and supportive learning environment.
