Our dedicated team of over 55 young professionals is harmonized with the needs and concerns of our youth.

Your Excellencies, dear Ministers of Foreign Affairs of the WB, I would like to seize this opportunity to request your assistance in finalizing the formal registration of our Local branch offices in the

region. With your support, 3 are already registered, and 2 more await completion, with hopes of proudly presenting these great results to your leaders, at the Summit of the Berlin process on October 16th, 2023.

In Tirana today, the "Youth Forum" as a side event to the Summit of the Berlin Process is happening. RYCO has gathered over 150 young leaders from across the region, to discuss the progress and new pillars of the Youth Berlin Declaration, adopted last year at the Berlin Summit, and will be presented later for your consideration.

We must rally behind them and follow their lead. Decades of conflicts in the Balkans pushed our region backward, and we must never allow history to repeat itself. In the words of a famous song, "Give peace a chance," and I dare to say, "Give youth a chance." The youth can be our strength in preserving peace and security in the region.

RYCO stands as a testament to the significant achievements of regional youth cooperation and peacebuilding. Let us not lose the path in this progress and remember that a better region starts with you and the youth — their energy, ideas, and hope.
