The Youth Cultural Fund has already reached over 10,000 participants in just one year. Furthermore, our **Shared Futures study** indicates over 68% of young people are willing to engage civil society and political activities.

Our latest **Systemic conflict analyses study** acknowledges that young people are aware of the shared concerns across the region, particularly regarding good governance and the decline in democratic standards. These challenges are not isolated to any single community or society. Despite the growing disenchantment with political systems, there is a tangible momentum—an opportunity to create a common WB reform agenda that bridges the divisions and contributes to stability. In this context, the European Union's credibility and the prospect of integration remain crucial.
