

# **RYCOGNIZED**

## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The RYCOGNIZED project aims to enhance policy effectiveness and foster lasting peace in the Western Balkans (WB6) by strengthening institutional trust and empowering youth to take an active role in decision-making. Building on the "RYCOGNIZED YPS Advocacy Efforts in WB6" initiative from 2023, which focused on Youth, Peace, and Security (YPS) actions in the region, the project continues to advance RYCO's advocacy efforts and institutional capacities within the YPS Agenda. By supporting RYCO's mission, it helps create an environment that promotes peacebuilding, regional youth cooperation, and improved youth representation. In 2023, 13 activities were carried out as part of these efforts, and in 2024, this number has grown to 29 activities, highlighting the project's growing impact.

**OBJECTIVES** 

**Overall objective:** Enabled environment in the Western Balkans fo peacebuilding, regional youth cooperation, and improving the position of youth.

**Specific objective:** To support the creation of the local and regional architecture for the implementation of the initiatives aimed at promoting youth involvement in peace and security through capacity building and investment in advocacy efforts.

## **OUTCOMES**

- Strengthened capacities of CSOs, expert communities, and RYCO staff on the Youth, Peace, and Security (YPS) Agenda.
- Increased number of advocacy initiatives on youth peace and security at local and regional levels.
- Development of the Peace Capital Methodology as a strategic framework for local peacebuilding efforts.
- Enhanced participation of young journalists in constructive peace reporting through the Peace Broadcasters initiative.
- Greater youth involvement in decision-making and policy development across the WB6 region.

#### **TARGET GROUP**

RYCOGNIZED brings together a diverse range of stakeholders across the Western Balkans (WB6) region, including youth organizations, activists, and civil society organizations (CSOs) dedicated to peacebuilding and reconciliation. It also involves government and policy stakeholders working on youth and security agendas, as well as young journalists and media professionals committed to constructive peace reporting. Researchers and academic institutions also contribute to the broader Youth, Peace, and Security (YPS) conversation. Throughout the project's implementation, over 750 participants have been engaged, with approximately 550 of them being young people. In another phase of the activities, more than 400 participants took part, including over 154 young individuals, and over 140 representatives from other stakeholder groups, reinforcing the project's commitment to inclusive and impactful engagement.

**BUDGET AND DURATION** 

The total budget for the RYCOGNIZED project from *August 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024*, is *299,760.00 EUR,* supporting its efforts to enhance youth engagement, peacebuilding, and institutional trust across the Western Balkans.
